Section 8.—Workers Affected by Collective Agreement

Statistics on the number of workers affected by collective agreements in Canada are compiled by the Department of Labour. Table 43 gives figures for the principal industrial groups. It shows in the second column the number of workers affected by agreements extended under the Quebec Collective Agreement Act (see Subsection 1, p. 696). Any duplication of the numbers of workers covered by agreements under this Act and by other agreements is eliminated in the third column. Of the total number of workers affected by agreements, 92 p.c. are represented by international or national unions. A more detailed table in the Labour Gazette, December, 1949, as well as studies of agreements in certain industries are available from the Department of Labour.
