## 8.—Capital, Revenues, Employees and Equipment of Motor-Carriers, 1947 and 1948

Table 9 shows the freight and passengers carried by motor-carriers in 1947 and 1948. Traffic data were not available for the majority of the small operators. Many truck operators failed to report tons of freight carried and others reported only estimates, consequently these data are not complete. A difficulty in compiling weights, which is quite understandable, is that much traffic is carried on a load basis and not on a weight basis. Records of passengers appear to be fairly complete, possibly because tickets are sold and accounted for, and the unit is not so complex as for freight carried.
