Subsection 2.—Debt of Provincial Governments

The average coupon rate of gross bonded debt of Provincial Governments decreased each year from $4 \cdot 12$ p.c. in 1942 to $3 \cdot 61$ p.c. in 1948. During these years also, the proportion payable in Canada only increased steadily, while that payable at New York showed a marked decline. Prince Edward Island had the lowest average coupon rate in 1948.
