Domestic disappearance of butter (creamery, dairy and whey) was approximately 317,251,000 lb. in 1951, compared with 325,755,000 lb. in 1950 and 336,671,000 lb. in 1943. Per capita figures for these years were $23\cdot25$ lb., $24\cdot38$ lb. and $23\cdot25$ lb., respectively. The per capita consumption of margarine for 1951 and 1950 was $7\cdot44$ lb. and $6\cdot76$ lb., respectively.

Total cheese consumption was about 65,561,000 lb. in 1951, an average of $4\cdot80$ lb. per capita. There was little change from the per capita consumption of the previous year.

The domestic disappearance of concentrated whole-milk products increased from $19 \cdot 77$ lb. per capita in 1950 to $20 \cdot 58$ lb. in 1951, and milk by-products from $6 \cdot 05$ lb. to $6 \cdot 56$ lb. in the same comparison.

Disappearance of all dairy products represented the equivalent of approximately 1,080 lb. of milk per capita in 1951 compared with 1,129 lb. in 1950.
