mately 9 p.c. Death rates for males up to age 45 have been roughly halved during the past 25 years; those for females in the same ages have been reduced as much as three to four times.

These reductions in the mortality rates in early and middle years of life have had the effect of increasing the number of people in the older age groups and of raising the average age of the population as a whole. As a natural consequence much larger proportions of deaths are now occurring at the older ages. Further, the reductions in rates will eventually raise the average age at death. In 1921 the average age at death of males was $39 \cdot 0$ years and of females $41 \cdot 1$ years; by 1954 this had advanced to $57 \cdot 3$ and $60 \cdot 0$ respectively. These trends are indicated clearly in Table 12.
