**Convictions of Females.**—The number of convictions against females for nonindictable offences was lower in 1953 by 16.5 p.c. as compared with 1952. Manitoba, New Brunswick, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and British Columbia recorded percentage decreases of 38.5, 25.5, 21.8, 17.6, 12.1 and 9.2 respectively. Traffic offences were the cause of 82.5 p.c. of all summary convictions against women but such convictions decreased by 19.3 p.c. in 1953 compared with 1952.
