are paid on the basis of the going salary in the area in which the individual works. Prevailing Rate Employees General Regulations also are applicable to the third major group entitled "ships' officers and crews". These three groups comprise what may be called the occupants of continuing positions in the governmental services. In addition, there is a group entitled "casuals and others" which includes persons occupying positions on a noncontinuing basis.

Employment of persons working in agency and proprietary corporations and other quasi-independent government bodies are detailed separately in Table 4 since they do not pay their employees from appropriations specifically designated for the payment of salaries or wages.
