Under the British Commonwealth Merchant Shipping Agreement all Commonwealth ships are given the general designation 'British Ship'; and a ship that should be but is not registered is not entitled to the privileges accorded to British ships. Ships in the planning stage or in course of construction may be recorded before registry by a Registrar of Shipping.

Shipping Traffic.—Complete statistics of shipping traffic, showing all the freight carried by water are not available. However, there is a record of the number and tonnage of ships calling at all ports at which there are customs collectors and of cargoes of vessels trading between Canadian and foreign ports. Commencing with 1957 these shipping statistics have been enlarged to include movement in and out of non-customs ports. Coastwise cargo has been reported from Jan. 1, 1952. Reports are not made for vessels of less than 15 registered net tons.
