Personnel.—Table 8 shows the provincial distribution at the end of 1958 of hospitalpaid personnel in health institutions classified according to type of service. General hospitals, with active treatment as their prime concern, had a relatively high ratio of 1,600.0 full-time and part-time employees per 1,000 beds, and well over three times more nursing personnel per 1,000 beds than hospitals of any other type. The highest ratio of medical staff per 1,000 beds was observable in tuberculosis institutions. Provincially, total staff and nursing personnel ratios were highest in Ontario for general hospitals (1,819.6 and 762.5 respectively); in Newfoundland for mental institutions (875.4 and 418.5); and in Nova Scotia for "other" hospitals (1,378.8 and 734.8). Among tuberculosis sanatoria, those in Nova Scotia employed the largest total staffs, and those in British Columbia the largest nursing staffs per 1,000 beds of rated capacity.
