



In 1905 the Provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan were created and the District of Keewatin transferred back to the newly defined North-West Territories (Northwest Territories in 1906).



In 1912, the Provinces of Ontario, Quebec and Manitoba were extended northward to Hudson Bay and Strait.



By 1925 Canada extended to the North Pole; in 1927 the Imperial Privy Council rendered a decision on the boundary between Newfoundland and Canada, and in 1949 Newfoundland was admitted to Confederation as Canada's Enth province.
