Other analyses of the content of the immigration movement in recent years are given in Tables 3 to 9. The numbers of persons deported from Canada for various reasons in the years 1951-60 are shown in Table 10.

Sex, Age and Marital Status.—In the ten-year period 1951-60 adult males comprised 40.6 p.c. of the immigrant arrivals, adult females 33.9 p.c. and children under 18 years of age the remaining 25.5 p.c. Without relation to age, 54.0 p.c. of the newcomers were males.
