Birthplace, Nationality and Origin.—Of the immigrant arrivals in 1960, 24.6 p.c. were born in Commonwealth countries or in the Republic of Ireland, compared with 22.4 p.c. in 1959, 25.0 p.c. in 1958, 41.8 p.c. in 1957, 33.5 p.c. in 1956, 30.3 p.c. in 1955, 31.2 p.c. in 1954 and 29.9 p.c. in 1953. In 1960, 34.5 p.c. of the newcomers were born in Italy, Germany or the Netherlands, 8.4 p.c. were born in the United States and 32.5 p.c. in other countries.
