

Of the males granted citizenship certificates in 1959, 21 p.c. were employed in manufacturing and mechanical occupations, 13 p.c. were employed in construction, 10 p.c. were labourers in other than primary industries, 8 p.c. were in service, 8 p.c. were in professional occupations, 6 p.c. in agriculture, 4 p.c. in transportation and communication and 4 p.c. in proprietary and managerial occupations. Of the females granted certificates, 54 p.c. were homemakers; among those employed outside the home, 28 p.c. were in clerical occupations, 27 p.c. in manufacturing and mechanical occupations and 25 p.c. in service occupations.
