Female Offenders.—There were 2,115 female offenders convicted of indictable offences in 1959, 42.7 p.c. of whom were in Ontario, 17.4 p.c. in British Columbia and 14.7 p.c. in Quebec. Of the total females convicted in that year, 54.8 p.c. were found guilty of theft and having in possession, 8.4 p.c. of false pretences and fraud and 6.9 p.c. of various assaults.
