It should be noted, too, that the total figures do not represent the actual number of children charged and found guilty but rather tend to exaggerate them, for a child referred to the court more than once during a year for different delinquencies is counted as a different case each time (see p. 330). Neither do the figures represent the number of delinquencies committed by delinquents because when a child is charged with more than one delinquency at a hearing only the most serious delinquency is counted.

Reports of juvenile delinquents were received in 1959 from 143 of the 169 judicial districts. Nine of these had no cases to report. Separate reports were received in 1959 from 195 incorporated urban centres of 4,000 or more population.

Juveniles brought before the Courts.—The number of juveniles brought before the courts in 1959 was 13,329, an increase of 1.5 p.c. over 1958. Saskatchewan and Prince Edward Island showed the greatest percentage increases among the provinces.
