Subsection 9.—Prices of Agricultural Products

The monthly index of farm prices of agricultural products was designed to measure changes occurring in the average prices farmers receive at the farm from the sale of farm products. In comparing current index numbers with those before August 1957, certain points should be considered. Western grain prices used in the construction of the index before Aug. 1, 1957 are final prices for all grains. Since that date only initial prices are available for western wheat, oats and barley. Subsequent participation payments made on the 1959 crops will be added to the prices currently used and the index revised upward accordingly.
