**Section 5.—Agricultural Statistics of the Census**

Brief statistical information on the tenure and condition of occupied farm land as reported at the 1951 and 1956 Censuses is given in the 1957-58 Year Book at pp. 455-456, and statistics for the same Censuses relating to farms, farm mechanization, electrification and area are included in the 1960 Year Book at pp. 499-501. More detailed information may be obtained from the *Census of Canada 1956*, Vol. II.

**1961 Census of Agriculture.**—Canada's tenth Decennial Census, which includes a Census of Agriculture, was taken on June 1, 1961. A series of bulletins giving results from the Census will be issued as the tabulated data become available, and it is expected that a good deal of agricultural information will be released before mid-1962. Provincial reports containing all published data from the Census of Agriculture should be published by early 1963. Summary statistics will be included in the 1962 Canada Year Book.
