Subsection 5.—Production of Fuels

Coal.—The downward trend in the production of coal, in evidence for some time, was interrupted in 1960 when tonnage mined increased by 5.6 p.c. and value by 3.0 p.c. over 1959. All producing provinces with the exception of Alberta showed some increase in output. Imports continued to decline but exports, mostly of bituminous coal, recorded a considerable increase in 1960.
