

Ontario continued to lead the provinces in value of fur production, accounting for 25 p.c. of the total in the 1959-60 season. Manitoba followed with 17 p.c., British Columbia with 16 p.c., Alberta 15 p.c., Saskatchewan 10 p.c., Quebec 9 p.c., the Atlantic Provinces 5 p.c., and the Yukon and Northwest Territories combined 3 p.c.
