Ontario has the greater production of the two provinces. In the production of wood products British Columbia, with 41 p.c. of the total, holds the dominant position, outranking both Ontario and Quebec which account for 25 and 22 p.c., respectively, of the total. In each of the other groups Ontario and Quebec lead by a wide margin.
