

Ontario has the greater production of the two provinces. In the production of wood products British Columbia, with 41 p.c. of the total, holds the dominant position, out-ranking both Ontario and Quebec which account for 25 and 22 p.c., respectively, of the total. In each of the other groups Ontario and Quebec lead by a wide margin.
