Employment in transportation, storage and communication continued to fall in 1960, when the index was lower by 2.8 p.c. than in 1959. Railroad staffs declined by 6.4 p.c. but there was a substantial rise in those engaged in air transport. For the second successive year, establishments in the communications industries reported smaller working forces. Public utility operation showed a slight reduction, the index at 137.8 being 0.9 points lower in 1960. The movement continued favourable in trade, finance, insurance and real estate, and in the service industries surveyed. In the latter two broad industrial divisions, employment has risen uninterruptedly over a period of many years; also, a minor decline in the index in trade in 1958 from 1957 was the only reversal of the steadily upward movement that has been recorded therein since 1943.
