The total tonnage of freight carried was 8.2 p.c. higher in 1959 than in 1958. Among the main commodity groups, agricultural products and animal products recorded decreases but mine products were up 18.8 p.c., forest products 1.2 p.c. and manufactures and miscellaneous products 5.6 p.c. Of the 166,095,149 tons moved in 1959 (excluding freight handled by more than one railway and in intermediate switching), mine products accounted for 42.9 p.c., manufactures and miscellaneous products for 29.6 p.c., agricultural products 16.8 p.c., forest products 8.9 p.c., animal products 0.9 p.c. and less than carload freight for 0.9 p.c.
