In the Yukon Territory, a \$5,000,000 road-construction program, involving the building of five large bridges, will be started during 1961. Some 110 miles of road will be built as part of three projects—the Flat Creek-Eagle Plain road, the Watson Lake Road to Ross River, and the Nahanni Range Road. The largest of these is the Watson Lake-Ross River project. Expenditure during the year on new roads and improvement of existing roads will amount to about \$3,500,000 and an estimated \$100,000 will be spent on surveys for future development roads.

Urban Roads.—Information on urban roads is obtained from urban authorities in all centres with populations of over 1,000 and also centres with fewer than 1,000 population located within census metropolitan areas. Brief statistical data are given in Table 3; more detail may be obtained from DBS annual report Road and Street Mileage and Expenditure (Catalogue No. 53-201).

Section 3.—Motor Vehicles

Registrations.—Motor vehicle registrations continue to increase year by year, a record of 5,017,686 being reached in 1959. Of that total, 3,812,422 were for passenger cars—one for every 4.5 persons. Registrations by province are given in Table 4 and types of vehicles registered by province in Table 5.
