Motion Picture Production.—Table 16 shows the operations of private firms in the production and printing of motion picture films and film-strips for industry, government, education, entertainment, etc. Films are also produced by government agencies but information concerning such production is, of course, not available. In addition, five firms in other business categories produced films in 1958 (one feature, seven television and 18 other non-theatrical, 288 newsreel and 21 commercial advertising) which brought them a revenue of \$101,000.

Table 17 shows types of film produced by private industry, classified by major producing region, and by government agencies during 1958 and 1959. Of the total of 514 films of five minutes or longer produced by private industry in 1959, 40 television and 15 other non-theatrical films were adaptations or language versions of original films; 11 were made for other than Canadian sponsors. Of the government films, 20 theatrical shorts, 10 television and 61 other non-theatrical films of five minutes or longer were adaptations or language versions of original films and one film was produced for a sponsor from outside Canada.
