Travel between Canada and Overseas Countries.—In 1959, non-immigrants arriving in Canada direct from overseas numbered 41,600, an increase of 3,200 or 8 p.c. over arrivals in 1958. An additional 25,000 were estimated to have come to Canada via the United States, making a total of 66,600 visits.

Of the \$40,000,000 in travel expenditures received from overseas residents, \$21,000,000 went to Canadian carriers for transportation services and the remainder was spent within Canada. Canadian air and steamship lines carried about 39 p.c. of the non-resident visitors entering Canada direct in 1959. Some 57 p.c. of the overseas visitors came by air.
