Subsection 2.—Fire Losses

The information in Tables 17 to 20, which deals with the loss of property and life caused by fire, has been summarized from the annual Statistical Report of Fire Losses in Canada prepared by the Dominion Fire Commissioner, Department of Public Works. Federal losses not included in these figures in 1959 amounted to \$6,256,719 from 3,718 fires.
