

Private intercity vehicles accounted for 20.2 p.c. of the total registrations and for 22.9 p.c. of the total net ton-miles performed; their average yearly mileage was 7,100, average load 4.5 tons, and mileage per gallon of gasoline 9.7. Private urban vehicles made up 40.3 p.c. of the total truck population but accounted for only 10.4 p.c. of the total net ton-miles performed by all vehicles. Almost three quarters of these vehicles were registered in the three Provinces of Ontario, Quebec and British Columbia.

Farm trucks amounted to 33.4 p.c. of the commercial vehicle registrations but of course accounted for only a small portion of the total net ton-miles performed. More than three quarters of all trucks registered in Saskatchewan and half of those registered in Manitoba and Alberta were used in farm operations, and more than 70 p.c. of all farm trucks in Canada were registered in the Provinces of Ontario, Saskatchewan and Alberta.
