In trade with countries other than the United States, food, feed, beverages, tobacco and other crude and fabricated materials made up 63% of total imports in 1974 and 81% of the import rise to overseas countries. Due to soaring prices, crude oil imports alone represented 25.5% of all purchases from overseas countries and 48.5% of the increase over 1973. Automotive imports from overseas countries rose some 20% in 1974.
